

## Aerial Lift Proficiency

The intent of this training is to maintain proficiency for operators who have previously been trained to operate Aerial Lifts at LLE. This procedure is to be performed in the presence of a qualified Aerial Lift Operator. You may not use this document to maintain proficiency if you have not previously received M\_008: Aerial Lift Safety Training.

### Preface:

Safe operation of the Aerial lifts at LLE requires awareness of your surroundings, understanding of the controls and safety features of the lift, and operational proficiency through regular operation of lifts and annual training.

**Perform the following functions under the watch of a qualified operator.**

### From the Platform:

- ☐ Raise and lower the lift.
- ☐ Drive forward and backward.
- ☐ Steer the lift left and right.
- ☐ Activate the horn.
- ☐ Activate the emergency stop (E-stop).

Note: If a lift does not automatically disable controls, it is considered a best practice to manually disable the controls while performing work for an extended period (>2 minutes).

### From the Ground:

- ☐ Identify the Ground/Platform control selector.
- ☐ With all E-stops released select Ground Controls and raise the platform at least 4 feet.
- ☐ Activate the ground E-stop and verify that the Ground Controls are no longer able to lower the platform.
- ☐ Using the Emergency Lowering Valve, lower the platform.

Once you have successfully performed all of these functions, sign this document and deliver to the Safety Office.
